Across borders

The municipality of Terneuzen is centrally located in Zeeuws-Vlaanderen. Together with the Ghent-Terneuzen Canal, our port city of Terneuzen can be seen as the economic kernel of the region, with the industrial canal zone being the outer husk. The warmth and friendliness of the region can be felt across the whole municipality, but especially in the surrounding villages and towns. We are part of the crossborder North Sea Port, which extends from Vlissingen to Ghent: a port area covering 60 kilometres. Right in the middle lies the dynamic port city of Terneuzen.

Naturally strong

Our location on the water means that we have a naturally strategic position, ensuring a large, international network. We work constantly on developing sustainability and strengthening our position economically. We carry this out in the Delta region that runs from West Brabant and Zeeland along the Canal




Many faces

Living with water



World-class lock complex

The lock complex in Terneuzen provides sea vessels with access to the ports of Terneuzen and Ghent and protects the hinterland from the sea. The New Lock will be the same size as the locks in the Panama Canal: 427 meters long, 55 meters wide and 16.44 meters deep. Extraordinary! 



















Facilities


Expat Center Zeeland


